LESSON OBJECTIVE

After completing this lesson, the children will learn that God always has been and always will be infinitely good.

Children will also learn that any of the good we have comes from God.

MEMORY WORK (6 minutes)

“For I am a great king,” says the LORD Almighty, and my name is to be feared among the nations.”

Malachi 1:14

(Children seated in semi-circle of chairs with white board at front) Write the memory verse on the white board leaving room in between each row. Tell them that this will be our memory verse for the unit on the Attributes of God.

Have the children say the verse out loud all together.

Draw a picture above each/most of the words to help the children remember that word. [Click here for example](#)

Have the children say the verse out loud all together again reading the pictures.

Erase the words leaving only the pictures.

Have the children say the verse out loud again.

SCRIPTURE READING AND DISCUSSION (10-15 minutes)

Introduction:

Give each child a copy of the assignment "[God is Good](#)" (Please note that you should print it out Landscape)

If you have fluent readers in your class, ask for three volunteers to read. Assign each of the three children a section to read aloud. (Otherwise the teacher should read each section to the class)

After each section is read, stop and ask each child to place a check mark by the statement that impressed them the most about God's goodness.

Read the directions at the bottom of the page and ask if there are any questions about the assignment.

Depending on the age of the children, take a few moments to discuss what a Bible concordance is and how to use it. As time permits look several of the passages up in class using a concordance. Tell the children that they are to find supporting verses for 2 or 3 of the remaining statements at home.

APPLICATION (2 minutes)
